RealDeal Theatre will choose the scripts and give each script to a professional director.

Script-in-hand semi-staged performances will take place on at 6.30 pm on Saturday, 29 June 2013 at Westminster Reference Library, 5 St. Martin's Street, London, WC2H 7HP, in London's West End.

To submit a script for Popcorn Saturday, please read the rules below and **send your script only between Monday 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 26<sup>h</sup> May 2013** to [scripts@realdealtheatre.org.uk](mailto:scripts@realdealtheatre.org.uk)

1 The script must be no longer than 15 minutes in performance and be inspired by a movie. It must be previously unperformed, must not contain defamatory material, be wholly or mostly in English and must be the writer's own work and copyright (writers retain their copyright).

2 As a rough rule of thumb, it should be no more than 10 - 15 pages long using standard playwriting format. Use a minimum of 12 point font. Double line spacing for dialogue is preferable. Put a page number and your name and contact details on every page. Make a difference between STAGE DIRECTIONS, CHARACTER NAMES & dialogue (eg stage directions & character names in upper case & dialogue in lower case).

3 Please also put in a character list and brief synopsis. Each character (actor) should have a substantial role (no bit parts or extras please) and no more than five characters.

4 Please keep stage directions pithy and clear. Don't get hung up on the staging or worrying about scene changes - that's up to the director.

5 The writer(s) of each play must be available to liaise with director and actors and must be present at Westminster Reference Library on the evening of Saturday, 29<sup>th</sup> June to see his, her or their play performed.

6 Remember "show not tell" - rather than make a character or characters tell what happened, far better to show the incident dramatically - it is still possible in 15 minutes or less!

9 Scripts will not be accepted outside official entry dates – 20<sup>th</sup> May to 26<sup>th</sup> May 2013. Please make sure you put your name and contact details clearly in the email and on each script page, which should be numbered. Your script should be in a popular software format, eg Microsoft Word, pdf, rtf, which can be easily opened. RealDeal Theatre's decision is final.
